Hold a public hearing and consider an ordinance on first reading changing the zoning use classification of the property described as a 4,344-square foot portion of Lot 1A, Block 2, Grandridge Park Addition, Section 7, City and County of Midland, Texas (Generally located west of the intersection of West Loop 250 North and Holiday Hill Road), which is presently zoned PD, Planned District for a Shopping Center, by permitting said property to be used under a Specific Use Permit with Term for the sale of beer and wine in a lounge for on-premises consumption; making said permit subject to certain conditions and restrictions contained herein; containing a cumulative clause; containing a savings and severability clause; providing for a maximum penalty or fine of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00); and ordering publication. (DEVELOPMENT SERVICES) (9678)
21. Hold a public hearing and consider an ordinance on first reading changing the zoning classification by amending Chapter One, Title XI, of the City Code of Midland, Texas, by permitting the correction plat of Pavilion Park, Section 8, City and County of Midland, Texas, which is presently zoned PD, Planned District for a Housing Development, to be used as an amended Planned District (Generally located north of Solomon Lane, approximately 840 feet east of North Lamesa Road); containing a cumulative clause; containing a savings and severability clause; providing for a maximum penalty or fine of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00); and ordering publication. (DEVELOPMENT SERVICES) (9679)
22. Hold a public hearing and consider an ordinance on first reading vacating and abandoning a 0.048-acre portion of alley right-of-way located in Tract 11, the Gardens Addition, City and County of Midland, Texas (Generally located on the north side of West Michigan Avenue, approximately 242 feet west of Andrews Highway); adopting the appraisal by the City Manager of \$5,275.60; and ordering recordation by the City Secretary. (DEVELOPMENT SERVICES) (9680)
23. Hold a public hearing and consider an ordinance on first reading changing the zoning use classification of the property described as a 3,300-square foot portion of Lot 1, Block 1, Mesa Verde Addition, City and County of Midland, Texas (Generally located southwest of the intersection of north Midland Drive and Neely Avenue), which is presently zoned LR-2, Local Retail District, by permitting said property to be used under a Specific Use Permit without Term for a veterinarian clinic; making said permit subject to certain conditions and restrictions contained herein; containing a cumulative clause; containing a savings and severability clause; providing for a maximum penalty or fine of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00); and ordering publication. (DEVELOPMENT SERVICES) (9681)

Hold a public hearing and consider an ordinance on first reading granting a special exception for Lot 1, Block 2, Berkshire Place, City and County of Midland, Texas (Generally located southeast of the intersection of North N Street and Boyd Avenue), by permitting a reduced side yard setback; containing a cumulative clause; containing a savings and severability clause; providing for a maximum penalty or fine of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00); ordering recordation by the City Secretary in the deed records of Midland County, Texas; and ordering publication. (DEVELOPMENT SERVICES) (9682)

Hold a public hearing and consider an ordinance on first reading granting a special exception for Lot 4, Block 4, Dunagan Addition, City and County of Midland, Texas (Generally located northeast of the intersection of Princeton Avenue and Lanham Street), by permitting an increased height of a fence within the front yard setback; containing a cumulative clause; containing a savings and severability clause; providing for a maximum penalty or fine of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00); ordering recordation by the City Secretary in the deed records of Midland County, Texas; and ordering publication. (DEVELOPMENT SERVICES) (9683)
