ISSUE: Certification of November 8, 2016 Municipal Election results.

BACKGROUND: On November 8, 2016, a Municipal Election was held for the purpose of electing Districts 1 and 3 Commissioners.

For the District 1 Commissioner a total of **6,026** votes were cast with Marlon Bolton receiving **3,547** votes and Pamela Bushnell receiving **2,479** votes.

For the District 3 Commissioner a total of **7,621** votes were cast with Therese J. (Terri) Andretta receiving **1,400** votes; Melvin Leonard Dubin receiving **1,031** votes; Julie Fishman receiving **2,779** votes; James A. Franko receiving **927** votes; Gerald Heller receiving **1,208** votes and Joseph Harry Scimeca, Sr. receiving **276** votes.
